**Circe's Grotto:** Made-to-order sandwiches, panini, wraps, and salads.



**Bodega CHS:** New York-style "Bodega" breakfast sandwiches, old school staples and great coffee.



**Queen Street Grocery:** Charming old-fashioned grocery and cafe offering breakfast, hot-pressed sandwiches, crepes, smoothies, and local craft beer/wines for takeaway or sidewalk dining.

**Millers All Day:** Celebrate the joys of breakfast with a focus on small batch grains, perfectly cooked eggs, delicious proteins, craft cocktails in a historic building.





# Dinner



## **Poogan's Porch:**

Charleston's oldest independent culinary establishment on Queen Street, serving fresh Lowcountry cuisine in a beautifully restored Victorian house, perfect for brunch and dinner.

## **The Ordinary:**

Upscale seafood restaurant housed in a 1920s bank with high ceilings, large windows, and a bar, specializing in fancy seafood and oysters.



**Mesu:** Artistic restaurant on King Street offering a combination of Mexican and Sushi inspired fare, with a full bar featuring sake, tequila, and cocktails.



**Stella's:** Classy Greek diner offering Greek dishes and meze to share, including a Mediterranean Sunday brunch.



**Coterie:** Trendy Indian restaurant with an inviting atmosphere serving contemporary dishes and cocktails.



**167 Sushi Bar:** Intimate sushi bar offering daily nigiri, sashimi, and unique hot items on King Street.



**Basic Kitchen:** Downtown eatery in a historic building with floor-to-ceiling windows and a covered courtyard, serving dishes featuring local produce and whole grains and seasonal cocktails.



# Drinks



**Pour Taproom:** Enjoy local craft brews and downtown views from a rooftop bar. Pour your own beer and pay by the ounce.

**Firefly Distillery:** Charleston's most visited distillery nestled among live oaks and Spanish moss, offering a variety of innovative spirits, including the world's first Sweet Tea Vodka. A charming setting with live music on Saturdays.



**Prohibition:** Rustic-chic Modern American restaurant with a Jazz Age theme, where you can indulge in inventive cocktails and sophisticated spins on Southern classics, including a casual tasting menu paired with dealer's choice beverage pairings.

**The Cocktail Club:** Stylish speakeasy-style bar on Charleston's upper King Street, offering craft cocktails, house-made infusions, and a rooftop terrace with a custom garden, all within a historic building featuring reclaimed wood and original accents.
